1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To commend Quentin D. Dastugue upon his induction into the Louisiana Political Museum
3 and Hall of Fame.

4 WHEREAS, a celebrated member of the state legislature for four terms, a candidate
5 for the U.S. Senate and governor, and recipient of the national "Legislator of the Year
6 Award" in 1994, Quentin D. Dastugue has been an important and influential figure in state
7 politics; and

8 WHEREAS, he was born on December 31, 1955, in New Orleans, and received a
9 Bachelor of Science from the Georgia Institute of Technology; and

10 WHEREAS, his business career began in real estate by managing office buildings
11 and shopping centers, but he quickly progressed to investment and sales brokerage until he
12 founded his own company, Property One, a full service commercial real estate firm that has
13 grown to be one of the largest in the region with over five offices in the state; and

14 WHEREAS, his career in state politics began in 1979, when he was elected to serve
15 the people of District 82 in the Louisiana House of Representatives, and would be elected
16 for four consecutive terms; and

17 WHEREAS, an influential legislator, he fought passionately to make the state a better
18 place, and as chairman of the House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public

1 Works, he was the author of the state Transportation Trust Fund legislation and fought
2 vehemently for reform of levee boards; and

3 WHEREAS, though no longer in elected office, he remains an active member of his
4 community and serves on numerous civic organizations, including the New Orleans
5 Regional Chamber of Commerce, as a youth basketball and softball coach for over twenty
6 years, and has been named "Realtor Associate of the Year" by the Jefferson Board of
7 Realtors; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Dastugue is married to his soul mate and best friend Penny
9 Matherne Dastugue and they have been blessed with three amazing daughters, Kaitlin,
10 Margaux, and Allison; and

11 WHEREAS, through his years of service and commitment to improving the lives of
12 his fellow citizens, Quentin D. Dastugue has rightly earned a place among the many legends
13 in the Louisiana Political Museum and Hall of Fame.

14 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
15 commend and congratulate Quentin D. Dastugue upon his induction into the Louisiana
16 Political Museum and Hall of Fame.
