Amendments proposed by Senator Claitor to Engrossed House Bill No. 727 by Representative Thibaut

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Senate Committee Amendments No. 10, proposed by the Senate Committee on
3 Judiciary C and adopted by the Senate on April 25, 2018.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, line 22, delete the "*" * *" and insert the following:

6 "D. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to apply to or prevent the following:
7 lawful assembly and peaceful and orderly petition for the redress of grievances, including
8 but not limited to any labor dispute between any employer and its employee.

9 (1) Lawful assembly and peaceful and orderly petition, picketing, or demonstration
10 for the redress of grievances or to express ideas or views regarding legitimate matters of
11 public interest, including but not limited to any labor dispute between any employer and its
12 employee or position protected by the United States Constitution or the Constitution of
13 Louisiana.

14 (2) Lawful commercial or recreational activities conducted in the open or unconfined
15 areas around a pipeline, including but not limited to fishing, hunting, boating, and
16 birdwatching.

17 (3) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prevent the owner of an immovable
18 from exercising right of ownership, including use, enjoyment, and disposition within the
19 limits and under the conditions established by law."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 3

21 On page 3, between lines 8 and 9:

22 "E. A person convicted under R.S. 14:26 of violation of R.S. 14:61.1 shall not
23 be limited by R.S. 14:26(D) where it is foreseeable that more than one human life
24 will be threatened as a result of such conduct, and each conspirator shall be
25 imprisoned at hard labor for no more than twelve years, fined not more than two
26 hundred fifty thousand dollars, or both."
