COURTS. Authorizes an increase in court costs in the mayor's court of the town of Livingston. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:447.16, to authorize certain court costs in the mayor's court of the town of
3 Livingston; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 33:447.16 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§447.16. Mayor's court; town of Livingston; court costs**

7 **Notwithstanding R.S. 33:441(A) nor any law to the contrary, the mayor**
8 **of the town of Livingston may impose court costs not to exceed fifty dollars for**
9 **each offense, as defined by ordinance, on any defendant convicted of a violation**
10 **of a municipal ordinance.**

11 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
12 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
13 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
14 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
15 effective on the day following such approval.
