25 2006 First Extraordinary Session, providing for the issuance of general
26 obligation bonds in the state which cannot be issued for the projects
27 contemplated, and in their stead to reauthorize general obligation bonds of the
28 state for those projects deemed to be essential, and to authorize new projects.

29 Section 19. It is the intent of the legislature that this Act shall constitute the
30 Omnibus Bond Authorization Act of 2020 and, together with any Act authorizing
31 the issuance of refunding bonds and Act 41 of the 2006 First Extraordinary
32 Session, shall provide bond authorization, as required by Article VII, Section 6
33 of the Constitution of Louisiana, for those projects to be funded totally or

22 in the fiscal year in which such project bonds are issued and in each fiscal year
23 thereafter until such project bonds and the interest thereon are paid, shall transfer
24 and make available to the state treasury, for deposit in the Bond Security and
25 Redemption Fund, designated student fees or revenues or other revenues in an
26 amount equal to the debt service on such project bonds in such fiscal year. In
27 addition, the applicable management board, governing body, or state agency, in
28 the fiscal year in which such project bonds are issued and in each of the nine
29 immediately succeeding fiscal years thereafter, shall transfer and make available
30 to the state treasury from designated student fees or revenues or other revenues,
31 for credit to a reimbursement reserve account for such project bonds which shall
32 be established in an account designated in the reimbursement contract hereafter
33 provided for, monies in an amount equal to one-tenth of the average annual debt
34 service on such project bonds, and each such reimbursement reserve account
35 thereafter shall be maintained in said minimum amount by further transfers, if
36 necessary, from designated student fees or revenues or other revenues by the
37 applicable management board, governing body, or state agency to the state
38 treasury. Each such reimbursement reserve account shall be used, if necessary,
39 solely to make the reimbursement payments herein obligated to be made to the
40 state treasury. When the general obligation bonds and the interest thereon issued
41 hereunder have been paid, any amount remaining in the reimbursement reserve
42 account, as prorated to such authorized project, shall be transferred by the state
43 treasurer to the applicable management board, governing body, or state agency.

44 (C) No project bonds authorized by this Section shall be issued for any
45 authorized project unless and until a reimbursement contract has been entered
46 into and executed between the applicable management board, governing body,
47 or state agency and the State Bond Commission pertaining to the reimbursement
48 payment and reimbursement reserve account payments for such project. The
49 contract shall require payment into the state treasury of designated student fees
50 or revenues or other revenues in an amount sufficient to reimburse the cost to the
51 state of the principal, interest, and premium, if any, obligated to be paid by the
52 state on such project bonds. The State Bond Commission shall not be required
53 to execute any such reimbursement contract unless the estimates and projections
54 of the designated student fees or revenues or other revenues available for
55 payment into the state treasury thereunder for the authorized projects are
56 sufficient to reimburse the costs of the principal, interest, and premium, if any,
57 on the project bonds. A reimbursement contract hereunder shall be authorized
58 by resolution of the applicable management board, governing body, or state
59 agency, or board or by act of the chief executive officer if no governing board
60 exists.

1 This authorization shall provide for the dates, amounts, and other details for
2 the payments required to be made to the state treasury and for the reserve
3 account. The authorization may contain such covenants with the State Bond
4 Commission regarding the fixing of rates for fees and charges or revenues and
5 such other covenants and agreements with the State Bond Commission as will
6 assure the required payments to the state treasury. The contract shall be subject
7 to approval by the Office of the Attorney General and the State Bond
8 Commission and, when so accepted and approved, shall conclusively constitute
9 and be the reimbursement contract for an authorized project, as required
10 hereunder.

11 (D) The obligation to make the reimbursement payments as required by a
12 reimbursement contract may be represented by the issuance by the applicable
13 management board, governing body, or state agency of its nonnegotiable revenue
14 obligation in the form of a bond or other evidence of indebtedness, hereinafter
15 referred to as "reimbursement bond". The reimbursement bond shall be issued
16 in a single bond form, without coupons, in the principal amount equal to the
17 aggregate principal amount of project bonds, shall be registered in principal and
18 interest in the name of and be payable to the State Bond Commission, shall bear
19 interest at a rate or rates equal to the interest rate or rates payable on the project
20 bonds, and shall be payable as to principal and interest at such times, in such
21 manner, from designated student fees or revenues, or other revenues, and be
22 subject to such terms and conditions as shall be provided in the authorizing
23 resolution or document executed by a chief executive officer, where applicable.
24 This authorization shall be subject to approval by the State Bond Commission
25 and the Office of the Attorney General, and when so accepted and approved, the
26 authorization shall constitute and be the reimbursement contract for such
27 authorized project, as required hereunder. The reimbursement bonds authorized
28 under the provisions of this Section may be issued on a parity with outstanding

36 authorized project have been paid, the applicable management board, governing
37 body, or state agency shall impose fees and charges in an amount sufficient to
38 comply with the covenants securing outstanding bonds and to make the payments
39 required by the reimbursement contract.

40 (E) In addition to the other payments herein required, reimbursement
41 contracts shall provide for the setting aside of sufficient student fees or revenues
42 or other revenues in a reserve fund, so that within a period of not less than ten
43 years from date of issuance of project bonds there shall be accumulated in a
44 reserve fund monies equal to a sum not less than the average annual debt service
45 requirements on such project bonds. Monies in the reserve fund shall be used for
46 the purpose of remedying or preventing a default in making the required
47 payments under a reimbursement contract. The reserve fund required hereunder
48 may consist of a reserve fund heretofore or hereafter established to secure
49 payments for reimbursement bonds of the applicable management board,
50 governing body, or state agency, provided that (1) payments from said reserve
51 fund to secure the payments required to be made under a reimbursement contract

60 Section 23. The bonds authorized to be sold by the State Bond Commission
61 pursuant to this Act shall be issued and sold in conformity with the provisions of

1 Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of Louisiana, R.S. 39:1361 through
2 R.S. 39:1367, and R.S. 39:1401 through R.S. 39:1430.1, and any amendments
3 thereto adopted prior to, at the same time as, or subsequent to, the effective date
4 of this Act. However, the provisions of R.S. 39:1365(9) shall not apply to any
5 bonds issued hereunder in the form of variable rate and/or tender option bonds
6 and that said bonds need not be issued in serial form and may mature in such
7 year or years as may be specified by the State Bond Commission. Should any
8 provision of this Act be inconsistent with any provision of the Louisiana Revised
9 Statutes of 1950, the provision of this Act shall govern. In connection with the
10 issuance of the bonds authorized hereby, the State Bond Commission may,
11 without regard to any other laws of the state relating to the procurement of
12 services, insurance, or facilities, enter into contracts upon such terms as it deems
13 advantageous to the state for (1) the obtaining of credit enhancement or liquidity
14 devices designed to improve the marketability of the bonds and (2) if the bonds
15 are structured as variable rate and/or tender option bonds to provide the services
16 and facilities required for or deemed appropriate by the State Bond Commission
17 for such type of bonds, including those of tender agents, placement agents,
18 indexing agents, remarketing agents, and/or standby bond purchase facilities.
19 The cost of obtaining credit enhancement or liquidity devices and fees for other
20 services set forth in this Section shall, if authorized by the State Bond
21 Commission, be paid from the Bond Security and Redemption Fund as a
22 requirement with respect to the issuance of the bonds authorized hereby. The
23 bonds shall be general obligations of the state of Louisiana, to the payment of
24 which, as to principal, premium, if any, and interest, as and when the same
25 become due, the full faith and credit of the state is hereby irrevocably pledged.
