16 On page 1, between lines 17 and 18, insert the following:

17 "§100.41. Legislative Intent
18 It is the intent of the Legislature to provide economic support to Louisiana
19 political subdivisions and businesses for costs incurred for and continued response
20 to the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic from federal funds provided
21 pursuant to Section 5001 of the CARES Act, which created the Coronavirus Relief
22 Fund from which the State received over one billion eight hundred million dollars
23 (CARES Act), of which the State's portion is over nine hundred ninety-one million
24 dollars. The State desires to use a portion of the remaining portion of the CARES
25 Fund monies in the amount of five hundred eleven million one hundred seventy-eight
26 thousand seven hundred four dollars for economic support through the Coronavirus
27 Local Recovery Program for local government units to be administered by the
28 division of administration and the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and
29 Emergency Preparedness. The State further desires to use a portion of the CARES
30 Fund monies in the amount of three hundred million dollars for the Louisiana Main
31 Street Recovery Program for economic support for eligible businesses to be
32 administered by the State Treasurer, all as established in this Subpart. The State
33 further desires to use a total of fifty million dollars, of which twenty-five million
34 shall come from the Coronavirus Local Recovery Fund and twenty-five million shall
35 come from the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Fund, for the funding of a one-time
36 hazard pay rebate for essential critical infrastructure workers.

38 AMENDMENT NO. 14

39 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 11 in their and insert in lieu thereof the following:

41 "C.(1) Pursuant to legislative appropriation, the treasurer is hereby authorized
42 and directed to deposit in and credit to the Allocation Fund five hundred ~~eleven~~
43 ~~million one hundred seventy-eight thousand seven hundred four~~ forty million four
44 hundred seventy-eight thousand seven hundred four dollars of the federal monies
45 allocated to Louisiana pursuant to Section 5001 of the CARES Act. The monies in
46 the Allocation Fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state
47 general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the Recovery Fund shall
48 be deposited in and credited to the Allocation Fund. Except as provided in this
49 Section and if applicable under federal guidelines, unexpended and unencumbered

1 monies in the Allocation Fund shall remain in the Allocation Fund. Monies in the
2 Allocation Fund shall be appropriated and used solely as provided in this Section.

3 (2) The treasurer shall transfer and deposit twenty-five million dollars of the
4 monies in the Allocation Fund to the Critical Infrastructure Workers Hazard Pay
5 Rebate Fund in the state treasury.

7 AMENDMENT NO. 15

8 On page 2, delete lines 25 through 29, and on page 3, delete lines 1 through 22, and insert
9 in lieu thereof the following:

10 "C. (1) Pursuant to legislative appropriation, the treasurer is hereby
11 authorized and directed to deposit in and credit to the Recovery Fund three hundred
12 million dollars of the federal monies allocated to Louisiana pursuant to Section 5001
13 of the CARES Act. The monies in the Recovery Fund shall be invested in the same
14 manner as monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of
15 monies in the Recovery Fund shall be deposited in and credited to the Recovery
16 Fund. Except as provided in this Section and applicable federal guidelines,
17 unexpended and unencumbered monies in the Recovery Fund shall remain in the
18 Recovery Fund. Monies in the Recovery Fund shall be appropriated and used solely
19 as provided in this Section.

20 (2) The treasurer shall transfer and deposit twenty-five million dollars of the
21 monies in the Recovery Fund to the Critical Infrastructure Workers Hazard Pay
22 Rebate Fund in the state treasury.

23 D. Up to five percent of the monies initially deposited in the Recovery Fund
24 shall be appropriated to the treasurer for use in Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021 to
25 develop procedures for the administration of and for the costs of administering the
26 Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program. Such expenses may include costs for the
27 treasurer and the legislative auditor for work performed in execution of the program.
28 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the treasurer may enter into
29 ~~a consulting services, professional services and Information and Technology~~
30 ~~Services contract contracts for the purpose of the procurement of any goods or~~
31 ~~services necessary to implement and expedite the distribution of funds appropriated~~
32 ~~for the Recovery Program as an emergency procurement procurements exempt from~~
33 ~~the provisions of the Louisiana Procurement Code and corresponding rules and~~
34 ~~regulations., to expedite the distribution of the funds appropriated for the Recovery~~
35 ~~Program.~~ The cost of such ~~contract contracts~~ shall be an administrative expense of
36 the Recovery Program.

38 §100.45. State Coronavirus Relief Fund

39 A. There is hereby created and established in the state treasury, as a special
40 fund, the State Coronavirus Relief Fund, hereinafter the "Relief Fund". ~~The treasurer~~
41 ~~is authorized and directed to deposit monies appropriated by the legislature from the~~
42 ~~CARES Fund to the Relief Fund.~~ On December 1, 2020, the treasurer is authorized
43 and directed to transfer any unobligated monies in the Coronavirus Local Recovery
44 Allocation Fund and the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Fund ~~Monies in the Relief~~
45 ~~Fund may~~ to be used by the State, subject to appropriation if the legislature is in
46 session, or the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, if the legislature is not in
47 session, for the purposes of providing monies to local government units, eligible
48 businesses, or the state in accordance with the provisions of this Subpart and the
49 CARES Act.

51 §100.48. Critical Infrastructure Worker's Hazard Pay Rebate Fund

52 A. There is hereby created and established in the state treasury, as a special
53 fund, the Critical Infrastructure Workers Hazard Pay Rebate Fund, hereinafter the
54 "Rebate Fund". The treasurer is authorized and directed to transfer twenty-five
55 million from the Coronavirus Local Recovery Allocation Fund and twenty-five
56 million from the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Fund for deposit to the Rebate
57 Fund.

1 B. The monies in the Rebate Fund shall be invested in the same manner as
2 monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the
3 Rebate Fund shall be deposited in and credited to the Rebate Fund. If applicable
4 under federal guidelines, unexpended and unencumbered monies in the Rebate Fund
5 shall remain in the Rebate Fund.

6 C. Monies in the Rebate Fund shall be appropriated to the state treasurer to
7 be used to provide a one-time hazard pay rebate to essential critical infrastructure
8 workers as provided in the Act which began as House Bill No. 70 of the 2020 First
9 Extraordinary Session of the Louisiana Legislature."
