3 to the authorization contained in Paragraph A of this Section shall
4 consist of twelve members as follows:

6 (f) One person, from a list of three submitted by the board of

8 an agent licensed by the Department of Insurance to sell worker's

20 Section 2. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of
21 the members elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to
22 the electors of the state of Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the
23 manner provided by law, a proposal to repeal Article XII, Section 8.1(C)(1)(h)
24 of the Constitution of Louisiana.

1 Section 3. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be
2 submitted to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the gubernatorial primary
3 election to be held in 2003.

4 Section 4. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at
5 said election there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of
6 the state shall be permitted to vote FOR or AGAINST, to amend the
7 Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as follows:

8 To provide for the appointment of certain members to the board
9 of directors of the Louisiana Workers' Compensation
10 Corporation; to allow the selection of one person from a list
11 submitted by the Louisiana Workers' Compensation
12 Corporation, who is a licensed workers' compensation insurance
13 agent and possesses executive level experience; to remove the
14 position for the representative of insurers licensed by the
15 Department of Insurance to issue workers' compensation
16 insurance policies in Louisiana; to allow the selection of two
17 people from a list submitted by the Louisiana Workers'
18 Compensation Corporation, who are residents of the state of
19 Louisiana, to represent the interest of the citizens of the state at
20 large; and to remove the provision allowing one representative
21 from the state office of risk management to serve on the board.

Abstract: Provides for the appointment of members to the board of directors of LWCC.

Present constitution provides for the appointment of a member to the board of directors who is an agent licensed by the Dept. of Insurance to sell workers' compensation insurance within the state and who possesses executive level experience in the workers' compensation insurance field.

Proposed constitutional amendment changes present constitution by requiring that the member be selected from a list of three that is submitted by the board of directors of LWCC.

Present constitution provides for the appointment of one representative of insurers licensed by the Dept. of Insurance to issue workers' compensation insurance policies within the state who possesses executive level experience in the same field.

Proposed constitutional amendment changes the selection to two persons from a list of three submitted by the board who are residents of the state to represent the interest of citizens of the state at large.

Proposed constitutional amendment removes provision for the appointment of one representative of the state office of risk management.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the gubernatorial primary election to be held in 2003.
