TAX/LOCAL. Constitutional amendment to provide an exemption from the ad valorem tax for consigned art for Orleans Parish. (1/1/07) (2/3-CA13s1(A))

1	A JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Proposing to add Article VII, Section 21(C)(19) of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative
3	to ad valorem property tax exemptions; and to specify an election for submission of
4	the proposition to electors and provide a ballot proposition.
5	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
6	elected to each house occurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, for
7	their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add Article VII,
8	Section 21(C)(19) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
9	§21. Other Property Exemptions
10	Section 21. In addition to the homestead exemption provided for in Section
11	20 of this Article, the following property and no other shall be exempt from ad
12	valorem taxation:
13	(C) * * *
14	* * *
15	(19) All artwork in Orleans Parish including sculptures, glass works,
16	paintings, drawings signed and numbered posters, photographs, mixed media,
17	collages, or any other item which would be considered as the material result of

a creative endeavor which are listed as a consignment article by an art dealer.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 7,
2006.
Section 3. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall become
effective January 1, 2007.
Section 4. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election
there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
to vote FOR or AGAINST, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall
read as follows.
To exempt consigned art from ad valorem property tax in Orleans Parish; that
is, all artworks such as sculptures, glass works, paintings, drawings, signed
and numbered posters, photographs, mixed media, collages, or any other item
which would be considered as the material result of a creative endeavor.
