ASSESSORS. Constitutional amendment to provide for a single assessor in Orleans Parish. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

1	A JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Proposing to amend Article VII, Section 24 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to provide for
3	a single tax assessor in Orleans Parish; and to specify an election for submission of
4	the proposition to electors and provide a ballot proposition.
5	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
6	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, for
7	their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to amend Article VII,
8	Section 24 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
9	§24. Tax Assessors
10	Section 24.(A) Election; Term. A tax assessor shall be elected by the
11	electors of each parish, Orleans Parish excepted. His term of office shall be four
12	years. His election, duties, and compensation shall be as provided by law.
13	(B) Orleans Parish. There shall be seven assessors in New Orleans, who
14	shall compose the Board of Assessors for Orleans Parish. One shall be elected from
15	each municipal district of New Orleans, and each shall be a resident of the district
16	from which he is elected. The assessors shall be elected at the same time as the
17	municipal officers of New Orleans, for terms of four years each. Their duties and

compensation shall be as provided by law.
(C)(B) Vacancy. When a vacancy occurs in the office of tax assessor, the
duties of the office, until filled by election as provided by law, shall be assumed by
the chief deputy assessor, except in Orleans Parish where the Board of Assessors
shall appoint an interim assessor.
Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 7,
2006.
Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election
there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
to vote FOR or AGAINST, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall
read as follows:
To provide for a single tax assessor in Orleans Parish. (Amends Article VII,
Section 24)

DIGEST

<u>Present constitution</u> provides for a tax assessor to be elected from each parish.

Present constitution provides for seven tax assessors for Orleans Parish to be elected one from each municipal district of New Orleans. Provides for election dates, residency requirements, and terms of office.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> deletes authorization for seven tax assessors in Orleans Parish. Provides for a single tax assessor in Orleans Parish.

Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 7, 2006.
