(Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the filling of a vacancy in a statewide elective office other than the office of

Constitutional amendment which provides for the filling of vacancies in statewide elective offices other than the office of governor by providing that if more than one year remains in the term of such a statewide elective office, the vacancy shall be filled by the first assistant to such elected official and in the case of the lieutenant governor, the person nominated by the governor and confirmed by the legislature, only until such office can be filled by election, either at a regular statewide or congressional election or if such an election is not available within a year of the vacancy, a special election called by the governor for such purpose.
