

Proposed constitutional amendment authorizes the legislature by law to create a corporation to serve as a central source principal economic development organization of the state and to provide that such entity is exempt from certain civil service provisions, excluding those provisions dealing with the code of ethics and other provisions. Authorizes such entity, as provided by law, to engage in cooperative endeavors for economic development purposes and to receive state funds as appropriated by the legislature for economic development purposes as provided by law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Commerce to the engrossed bill.

1. Clarifies that the corporation is not exempted from the code of ethics and other provisions.
