HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Triche to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 1 by Senator Dardenne et al.

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 8, line 17, after "Funding." and before "Appropriations" insert a "(1)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 9, line 1, before "postsecondary" insert "each"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 9, line 1, delete "education" and insert "educational institution"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 9, between lines 6 and 7, insert:

9 "(2) In addition to the provisions of Subparagraph (1) of
10 this Paragraph, annual appropriations from the state general
11 fund for each higher education institution supervised and
12 managed by any of the higher education management boards for
13 a total of three consecutive fiscal years beginning with the fiscal
14 year in which a new community college located in the parish in
15 which the higher education institution is located or in one of the
16 immediately surrounding parishes opens and begins enrolling
17 students shall be no less than the appropriations from the state
18 general fund for the respective higher education institution,
19 regardless of its management board, for the fiscal year in which
20 state general fund appropriations for such higher education
21 institution were highest during the period from the 1998-1999
22 fiscal year through the fiscal year immediately prior to that year
23 in which the new community college opens and begins enrolling
24 students. In addition to the provisions of Subparagraph (1) of
25 this Paragraph, annual appropriations from the state general
26 fund for each postsecondary vocational-technical educational
27 institution for the five consecutive fiscal years beginning with
28 the fiscal year in which a new community college located in the
29 parish in which the postsecondary vocational-technical
30 educational institution is located or in one of the immediately
31 surrounding parishes opens and begins enrolling students shall
32 be no less than the appropriations from the state general fund for
33 the respective postsecondary vocational-technical educational

1 institution for the fiscal year in which state general fund
2 appropriations for such postsecondary vocational-technical
3 educational institution were highest during the period from the
4 1998-1999 fiscal year through the fiscal year immediately prior
5 to that year in which the new community college opens and
6 begins enrolling students. The provisions of this Subparagraph
7 shall be null and void on July 1, 2009.

8 (3) No tenured instructional employee of any higher
9 education institution or any vocational-technical school shall
10 lose his instructional position at such institution or school as a
11 result of any reduction in funds or financial exigency which
12 results from the opening of a new community college which has
13 begun to enroll students during the time period beginning three
14 years from the date such new community college began to enroll
15 students."
