

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 601 by Representative Bowler

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE: (Constitutional Amendment) Provides with respect to administrative law, administrative law judges, and judicial review of administrative agency determinations

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Removes provision that the system of administrative law is to commence and handle all adjudications; instead provides that it is to commence and handle adjudications.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Abstract: Authorizes the legislature to create a system of administrative law, to provide for administrative law judges and for judicial review of administrative agency determinations.

Proposed constitutional amendment authorizes the legislature to create a system of administrative law to commence and handle adjudications in the manner required by the Administrative Procedure Act, provide for the employment, qualifications, and authority of administrative law judges, and provide relative to access to the courts by a governmental agency or public official seeking judicial review of an administrative agency determination.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the gubernatorial primary election to be held in 2003.
