## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Downer to Reengrossed House Bill No. 640 by Representative Downer, et al.

1     AMENDMENT NO. 1

2     Delete Amendment No. 16 in the set of 32 amendments proposed by  
3     Representative Downer and adopted by the House on May 25, 1999.

4     AMENDMENT NO. 2

5     On page 3, between lines 17 and 18 insert the following:

6                     "(2) Appropriations from the Health Trust shall be restricted to  
7                     the following purposes:

8                     (a) Initiatives to ensure the optimal development of Louisiana's  
9                     children through the provision of appropriate health care.

10                    (b) Initiatives to benefit the citizens of Louisiana with respect to  
11                    health care through pursuit of innovation in advanced health care  
12                    sciences, and the provision of comprehensive chronic disease  
13                    management services."

14    AMENDMENT NO. 3

15    On page 3, at the end of line 25, change "care." to:

16                    "care, to include:

17                    (i) Early childhood intervention programs targeting children  
18                    from birth through age four, including programs to reduce infant  
19                    mortality.

20                    (ii) Support of the state's program for children's health  
21                    insurance.

22                    (iii) School-based health clinics, rural health clinics, and primary  
23                    care clinics."

24    AMENDMENT NO. 4

25    Delete Amendment No. 29 in the set of 32 amendments proposed by  
26    Representative Downer and adopted by the House on May 25, 1999.

27    AMENDMENT NO. 5

28    On page 5, line 12, after "monies" delete the remainder of the line and delete  
29    lines 13 through 15 and insert:

1 "from the TOPS Trust not to exceed the annual earnings on the  
2 investment for students of Louisiana institutions of  
3 postsecondary education; to authorize appropriation of monies  
4 from the Health Trust not to exceed the annual earnings on the  
5 investment of the trust for the purpose of initiatives for health  
6 care for children, innovations in health care sciences, and  
7 disease management services; to authorize"
