

Present constitution provides that the funds, credit, property, or things of value of the state or of any political subdivision shall not be loaned, pledged, or donated to or for any person, association, or corporation, public or private.

Proposed constitutional amendment allows the state to donate asphalt removed from state roads and highways to the parish or municipal governing authority where the asphalt was removed or, if not needed, to any other parish or municipality. Requires that such donation shall only be made pursuant to a cooperative endeavor between the state and the local governing authority.
