HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Windhorst to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 245 by Senator Hines and Representative Windhorst, et al.

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Conforming Amendment No. 5 proposed by Representative Windhorst
3 and adopted by the House of Representatives on May 21, 1999

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 4, delete lines 20 through 27 in their entirety and on page 5, delete
6 lines 1 and 2 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

7 "To limit the legislature to and provide for consideration of not
8 more than five prefiled bills which are not within the subject
9 matter limitations during regular sessions in even-numbered
10 years; to provide that the legislature, during sessions in even-
11 numbered years, may consider legislation which levies,
12 authorizes, increases, decreases, or repeals a fee or which
13 dedicates revenue and properly advertised local and special
14 bills; to require prefiling of bills, subject to certain exceptions,
15 no later than five o'clock on the tenth calendar day prior to the
16 first day of a regular legislative session; to change the date that
17 regular legislative sessions convene; to extend the length of
18 regular session in even-numbered years; to provide for time
19 limits for the introduction and consideration on final passage of
20 matters intended to have the effect of law; and to provide that
21 the legislature may change procedural matters relating to
22 sessions only by a two-thirds vote. (Amends Article III, Section
23 2(A))"
