SCHOOLS

Purpose of Bill: Repeals provisions that grant authority for a separate school system in certain wards of Rapides Parish.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Two tables showing estimated fiscal impact for expenditures and revenues from 1999-00 to 2003-04, including a 5-year total. Expenditures show a decrease in local funds, while revenues remain at zero.

EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

EXPENDITURES:

This bill will decrease local expenditures. Repealing the provisions that require a separate school system in Wards 9, 10, and 11 of Rapides Parish will eliminate expenditures expected to be incurred to establish and maintain that school system.

There is no anticipated direct effect on state and federal expenditures. The per pupil allocations currently made to the Rapides Parish School District will be associated with those students regardless of whether they attend the existing school district or a newly created school system within the parish.

REVENUES:

There is no anticipated direct effect on revenues as a result of this measure.
