12 Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election
13 there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
14 to vote FOR or AGAINST, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall
15 read as follows:

16 To provide that the director, deputy director and all employees of the
17 Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness shall
18 be in the unclassified service of the state civil service.

Walsworth (SB 209)

Proposed constitutional amendment provides that the director, deputy director and all
employees of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness
shall be in the unclassified service of the state civil service.

Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on
November 2, 2010.
