





a threat to public health or safety, and if he does not repurchase the property, the property is then required to be offered at public sale.

Proposed law removes the requirement that the property be offered back to the original owner who allowed the property to become a threat to public health or safety and the requirement of public sale.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 2, 2010.
