**Abstract:** Updates applicability of provisions in the Louisiana Constitution relative to required minimum bids in tax sales as a result of the 2010 census.

Present law provides that if property located in a municipality with a population of more than 450,000 persons as of the most recent federal decennial census fails to sell for the minimum required bid in the tax sale, the collector may offer the property for sale at a subsequent sale with no minimum required bid.

Proposed law retains present law, but changes the population restriction from 450,000 persons to the city of New Orleans.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Oct. 22, 2011.
