SENATE BILL NO. 97

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 18:1505.2(Q), relative to campaign finance; to prohibit the contribution, loan, expenditure, transfer, or other use of certain funds; to provide for penalties; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 18:1505.2(Q) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1505.2. Contributions; expenditures; certain prohibitions and limitations

* * *

R.S. 18:1505.2(Q) is all new law.

Q. No funds contributed which are subject to the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, to or for a person who seeks election to an office subject to the provisions of said Act shall be transferred, loaned, or contributed by a candidate, his agent, or his federal campaign committee to the candidate, any political committee of such candidate, or to any other political committee which supports the candidate; nor shall the candidate, his federal campaign committee, or his agent use such funds to otherwise support his candidacy.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and

subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
