CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE: Provides with respect to the exemption of fees for certain expungement cases

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 44:9(K)(4), relative to expungement of arrest records in misdemeanor and  
3 felony cases; to provide for an exemption of fees in certain expungement cases; and  
4 to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 44:9(K)(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §9. Records of violations of municipal ordinances and of state statutes classified as  
8 a misdemeanor or felony

10 K. The following applicants for expungement shall not be required to pay  
11 any fee to the clerk of court, the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information,  
12 sheriff, the district attorney, or any other agency to obtain or execute an order of a  
13 court of competent jurisdiction to expunge the arrest from the individual's arrest  
14 record if a certification obtained from the district attorney is presented to the clerk  
15 of court which verifies that the applicant has no felony convictions and no pending  
16 felony charges under a bill of information or indictment and at least one of the  
17 following applies:
