GAMING. Provides relative to suitability standards. (8/1/14)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 27:28(E) and 431(D), relative to gaming; to prohibit application  
3 for certain approval, licenses, and permits for a period of five years under certain  
4 circumstances; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 27:28(E) and 431(D) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as  
7 follows:

8 §28. Suitability standards

10 E. ~~Any person whose license or permit has been revoked or who has been~~  
11 ~~found unsuitable in this state or any other jurisdiction is not eligible to obtain any~~  
12 ~~license or permit pursuant to the provisions of this Title for a period of five years~~  
13 ~~from the date the revocation or finding of unsuitability becomes final.~~ **A person**  
14 **who has been found unsuitable or whose license, permit, or approval has been**  
15 **revoked, in this state or any other jurisdiction, may not apply for a license,**  
16 **permit, or approval or a finding of suitability for five years from the date there**  
17 **was a finding of unsuitability, or the license, permit, or approval was revoked,**



Proposed law requires the Gaming Control Board to promulgate rules necessary to carry out proposed law restrictions.

Effective August 1, 2014.
