Provides relative to the civil service status of employees of the housing authority of Denham Springs

Purpose of Bill: This measure provides that employees of the Housing Authority of Denham Springs would no longer be included in the State Civil Service.

There may be a minimal decrease of local fund expenditures as a result of the bill.
