
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2015 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment to
Original House Bill No. 668 by Representative Hill

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 9, after "waters;" insert the following:

3 "to require wildlife agents to wear body cameras;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, between lines 13 and 14, insert the following:

6 "Section 2. From August 1, 2015 to August 1, 2018, a wildlife agent shall
7 wear an electronic device capable of recording video and audio data or capable of
8 transmitting video and audio data to be recorded remotely at all times while
9 enforcing turtle excluder device requirements."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 1, at the beginning of line 14, change "Section 2." to "Section 3."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 1, after line 18, insert the following:

14 "Section 4. After the passage of this Act, any person operating as a
15 retail seller of seafood who boycotts or otherwise refuses to purchase shrimp
16 caught in Louisiana waters shall not be eligible for any tax credit or rebates
17 or any other type of incentive provided by the state."
