**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

2015 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs  
to Original House Bill No. 623 by Representative Reynolds

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 6, after "taxes" and before "to provide" delete the semi-colon ";" and insert  
3 a comma "," and "subject to voter approval;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, delete lines 7 through 13 in their entirety and insert the following:

6 "A. The district, through its governing authority, may levy and collect an ad  
7 valorem tax not to exceed eight mills on the dollar of assessed valuation on all  
8 taxable property situated within the boundaries of the district. The district may levy  
9 the tax only if the amount, term, and purpose of such tax, as set out in a proposition  
10 submitted to a vote in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code, has been  
11 approved by a majority of the qualified electors of the district voting on the  
12 proposition at an election held for that purpose.

13 B. The taxes shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as  
14 all other ad valorem taxes on property subject to taxation by the parish of Webster.

15 C. The revenue generated by the tax levied pursuant to this Section is not  
16 subject to deductions for retirement systems."

17 AMENDMENT NO. 3

18 On page 3, line 22, after "with" delete the remainder of the line and insert "any parish  
19 inmate."
