FAMILY LAW

RE NO IMPACT See Note

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Provides for parental authority of married persons, obligations of children, parents, and other ascendants, and provisional custody by mandate. (1/1/16)

Proposed law provides for revision regarding the following: (1) Parental Authority of Married Persons; (2) Obligations of Children, Parents, and Other Ascendants; and (3) Provisional Custody by Mandate. Proposed law provides that a married father and a mother share parental authority over their minor child(ren). Proposed law provides that each parent has the right and the obligation to administer the property of their unemancipated minor child(ren). Proposed law provides for the rights and obligations of parents who administer the property of their unemancipated minor child(ren) as well as suppresses exceptions provided in present law. Proposed law provides that an unemancipated minor child nor any person having parental authority over him/her may sue each other. Proposed law suppresses existing law regarding illegitimate children. Proposed law provides for venue for actions to seek court approval by parents during marriage. Proposed law provides a list of the acts which a person having parental authority may perform without court approval. Proposed law provides for separate rules for persons having parental authority and for tutors regarding provisional custody by mandate.
