1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the end of line 14, change "hearing impaired" to "**deaf, hard of hearing, or**
3 **deaf-blind**"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 16, between "**schools**" and "**shall**" insert "**and all publicly funded early**
6 **intervention programs**"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, line 4, between "**schools**" and "**shall**" insert "**and all publicly funded early**
9 **intervention programs**"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, delete lines 10 through 16, and insert "**schools shall inform the parents or**
12 **guardians of children who are deaf, hard of hearing, or deaf-blind of all State Board**
13 **of Elementary and Secondary Education policies and regulations relative to placement**
14 **considerations and options available to children who are deaf, hard of hearing, or deaf-**
15 **blind and provide opportunities for parents and guardians to fully participate in the**
16 **development and implementation of their child's education plan.**"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 3, delete lines 3 through 6, and insert "**of every student with an exceptionality**
19 **who is deaf, hard of hearing, or deaf-blind. Where appropriate, public schools shall**
20 **include a communication plan in the Individual Accommodation Plan for a student**
21 **who is deaf, hard of hearing, or deaf-blind.**"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 6

23 On page 3, line 10, between "degree" and "of hearing" insert "**and type**"

24 AMENDMENT NO. 7

25 On page 3, line 19, change "**provide technical assistance**" to "**work with local education**
26 **agencies to ensure technical assistance is available**"

27 AMENDMENT NO. 8

28 On page 3, line 27, change "deafness and hearing loss" to "**individuals who are deaf, hard**
29 **of hearing, or deaf-blind**"
