Proposed law amends and reenacts certain parts of R.S.33:2504 (B) and (C) and 2564(B) and (C), relative to civil service; to provide relative to civil service employees; to provide for investigation of civil service employee violations; to provide for a public hearing; and to provide for related matters.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material impact on state governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The proposed law directs the appointing authority to conduct an investigation of any person alleged to have violated regarding certain prohibited political activities. However, proposed law provides for certain penalties for certain violations of prohibited political activity if a civil service employee is determined to be guilty of violating one or more provisions. The penalties range from a suspension for thirty work days without pay for a first conviction to termination upon the determination of a violation of a second offense.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material impact on state governmental revenue as a result of this measure.
