Claitor

Prior law provided that any person entering an alcoholic beverage outlet by the fact of such entering is deemed to have consented to a reasonable search of his person for any firearm by a law enforcement officer or other person vested with police power, without the necessity of a warrant. However, in the case of *Ringe v. Romero*, 624 F. Supp. 417, 418-19, 425 (W.D. La. 1985), the court held that the warrantless search authorized by present law was unconstitutional.

New law repeals statute held unconstitutional.

Effective August 1, 2016.
