Requests the committee on parole to conduct a comprehensive review of parole matters from July 1, 2006 through July 1, 2016 and to submit a written report on these matters to the Senate Committee on Judiciary C, the House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice, the First Circuit Court of Appeal, and the La. Supreme Court.

Further provides that this report should contain the number of inmates appearing before the committee on parole or the former Board of Parole for parole consideration during this ten-year time period, the number of inmates granted parole and denied parole, the calculated percentages of those granted parole and denied parole, the underlying criminal offense for which each inmate is or was incarcerated, and the reasons or criteria utilized in each case and upon which the decision to grant or deny parole was based.
