1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 15:541.1(A), relative to the posting of the National Human
3 Trafficking Resource Center hotline; to require hotels to post information regarding
4 the hotline; to provide for the location of the posting; to provide for definitions; and
5 to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 15:541.1(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

8 §541.1. Posting of the National Human Trafficking Resource Center hotline;
9 content; languages; notice; civil penalty

10 A. All of the following establishments shall be required to post information
11 regarding the National Human Trafficking Resource Center hotline:

12 (1) Every massage parlor, spa, or hotel that has been found to be a public
13 nuisance for prostitution as set forth in R.S. 13:4711.

14 (2) Every strip club or other sexually-oriented business as set forth in R.S.
15 37:3558(C).

16 (3) Every ~~full-service~~ **full-service** fuel facility adjacent to an interstate
17 highway or highway rest stop.

18 (4) Every outpatient abortion facility as defined by R.S. 40:2175.3.

19 **(5)(a) Every hotel as defined in this Paragraph. Each hotel shall post the**
20 **information in the same location where other employee notices required by state**
21 **or federal law are posted.**

22 **(b) For purposes of this Paragraph, "hotel" shall mean and include any**
23 **establishment, both public and private, engaged in the business of furnishing or**
24 **providing rooms and overnight camping facilities intended or designed for**
