Colomb

Creates the State Capitol Accessibility Advisory Commission to study and make recommendations to the legislature for a strategic outlook to make sure the American with Disabilities Act of 1990, is sufficiently implemented with respect to the state capitol building and surrounding infrastructure and submit a report to the legislature by March 1, 2017.

Provides that the commission consist of 13 commissioners, who shall serve without compensation. Members include the following persons or their designees:

- (1) The chair of the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs or her designee.
- (2) The chairman of the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs or his designee.
- (3) The chairman of the Senate Select Committee on Homeland Security.
- (4) The chairman of the House Select Committee on Homeland Security.
- (5) One member of the Senate appointed by the president of the Senate.
- (6) One member of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker of the House.
- (7) One member consisting of a representative of the state fire marshal's ADA Enforcement Personnel designated by the state fire marshal.
- (8) One member consisting of the chair of the Development Disabilities Council or his designee.
- (9) The chair of the Advocacy Center or his designee.
- (10) The chair of the Louisiana Assistive Technology Access Network or his designee.
- (11) The chair of the Statewide Independent Living Council or his designee.
- (12) One member from the Louisiana Commission for the Deaf.
- (13) One member from the Louisiana Council of the Blind.

Requires that the commission convene no later than September 1, 2016 and that a report be presented to the legislature by March 1, 2017.
