MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Requires the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to issue an economic hardship license under certain circumstances

**Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to issue an economic hardship license for a period of one year or until such time as the individual has paid or made payment arrangements, as described in present law, instead of for a period of two years.

**Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

Present law prohibits the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles from issuing an economic hardship license to a person whose driver's license is suspended and has not been renewed because of delinquent state taxes.

Proposed law modifies present law by requiring the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to issue an economic hardship license to a person whose driver's license is suspended and has not been renewed because of delinquent state taxes. Specifies that the economic hardship license is valid for a period of one year or until such time as the individual has paid or made payment arrangements relative to his state tax delinquency.
