

## **RÉSUMÉ DIGEST**

**ACT 547 (HB 385)**

**2016 Regular Session**

**Hazel**

New law prohibits any person from knowingly giving or placing on any bail bond or declaration of residence false, nonexistent, or incomplete information for purposes of service or notice.

New law provides criminal penalties for misdemeanor cases including imprisonment for not more than six months, a fine of not more than \$500, or both. For felonies, the criminal penalties include imprisonment at hard labor for not more than two years.

Effective August 1, 2016.
