Prior law required all parties' birth dates on documents or acts evidencing a privilege that are filed for recordation.

New law eliminates this requirement.

Existing law requires that an act of sale of immovable property or attachment thereto filed for registry in the office of the parish recorder designate the name of the person responsible for all property taxes and assessments and include the address where property tax and assessment notices are to be mailed.

New law retains existing law but expands the requirements to any act of conveyance.

Effective August 1, 2016.
