Prior law prohibited the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, from issuing an economic hardship license to a person whose driver's license was suspended or had not been renewed because of delinquent state taxes.

New law requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to issue an economic hardship license to such a person. Specifies that the economic hardship license is valid for one year or until such time as the individual has paid or made payment arrangements relative to his state tax delinquency, whichever is shorter.

Effective August 1, 2016.
