SENATE BILL NO. 187

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

FISCAL CONTROLS. Provides for implementation of an evidenced-based budget process for certain programs. (7/1/17)

1 AN ACT  
2 To enact R.S. 39:2(13.1), (33.1), (36.1), (36.2), (37.1), (37.2), (37.3), (40.1), and 87.7 and  
3 to repeal R.S. 39:2(38) and (39), relative to the budget process; to provide for the  
4 development of evidenced-based budgeting practices that will enable data-driven  
5 budget decisions in selected policy areas; to require the Legislative Fiscal Office to  
6 inventory programs, costs, and outcomes and determine benefit-cost ratios; to  
7 provide the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget with data to enable the  
8 prioritization of funding; to require the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget  
9 to make certain recommendations; to provide for certain terms and definitions; and  
10 to provide for related matters.

11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

12 Section 1. R.S. 39:2(13.1), (33.1), (36.1), (36.2), (37.1), (37.2), (37.3), (40.1), and  
13 87.7 are hereby enacted to read as follows:

14 §2. Definitions

15 As used in this Chapter, except where the context clearly requires otherwise,  
16 the words and expressions defined in this Section shall be held to have the meanings  
17 here given to them.

**(13.1) "Evidence-based program" means a program or practice that has had multiple site random controlled trials across heterogeneous populations demonstrating that the program or practice is effective for the population.**

**(33.1) "Other programs and activities" means all programs and activities that do not fit the definition of evidence-based, research-based, or promising practices programs.**

\* \* \*

~~(38)~~**(36.1) "Performance-based budget" means a budget which relates funding to expected results.**

~~(39)~~**(36.2) "Performance standard" means the expected level of performance associated with a particular performance indicator for a particular period.**

**(37.1) "Program catalogue" means a compendium of programs compiled by a reputable source that publishes information for use by the government.**

**(37.2) "Program inventory" means the complete list of all agency programs and activities that meet any definition set out in this Section.**

**(37.3) "Promising practices" means a practice that presents, based upon preliminary information, potential for becoming a research-based or evidence-based program or practice.**

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~~(38) "Performance-based budget" means a budget which relates funding to expected results.~~

~~(39) "Performance standard" means the expected level of performance associated with a particular performance indicator for a particular period.~~

**(40.1) "Research-based program" means a program or practice that has some research demonstrating effectiveness, but that does not yet meet the**





programs.

- (3) Determine benefit-cost ratios for all evidence-based programs in the selected policy areas.

Proposed law also requires the Legislative Fiscal Office to report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget the results of all activities, with recommendations for further evaluation of research-based or promising practices programs, the elimination or replacement of ineffective programs, and the funding of effective programs, based on benefit-cost ratios and the learnings gained. Proposed law further specifies that the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget may incorporate such recommendations into the Fiscal Year 2019 budget and appropriations bills, or delay such incorporation until the committee is satisfied that the information collected and inventoried will enhance accountability and performance measurement for the programs and activities of state agencies.

Proposed law also requires the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget to, no later than the 2020 Regular Session of the Legislature, make a recommendation to the legislature regarding the application of the processes and requirements of this Section to other policy areas with evidenced-based programs.

Effective July 1, 2017.
