Present law provides with respect to reverse auctions and authorization thereof; provides for methods of procurement; and provides for advertisement or notice of purchase.
Proposed law provides with respect to reverse auctions and uses thereof; provides for advertisement or notice of purchase; requires the Office of State Procurement to report annually to the legislature by September 1, on the use of reverse auctions and any savings achieved.
