TO INTRODUCE BILL - SLS
18RS-163)

Public notice is hereby given that there may be introduced at the session of the Legislature to be convened on March 12, 2018, one or more bills relative to the Greater New Orleans Expressway Commission; to remove authority for the Commission to secure any bonds issued on or after March 12, 2018, including refunding bonds, with State Highway Fund No. 2 monies; to provide with respect to the authority of the Department of Transportation and Development to secure bonds related to projects in parishes where the motor vehicle license tax is dedicated to State Highway Fund No. 2 and then only on a per-capita basis among those parishes; to provide that the Commission is the only entity that may secure bonds with revenues derived from the operation of the Greater New Orleans Expressway; and to provide for related matters.
