INSURANCE: Provides for insurance producer preclicensing program requirements

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1571(E)(1), relative to insurance producers preclicensing
3 programs; to exempt bail bond producer preclicensing programs from certain
4 requirements; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 22:1571(E)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §1571. Registered insurance producer and bail bond producer preclicensing program

8 * * *

9 E.(1) Each registered insurance producer ~~or bail bond producer~~ preclicensing
10 program for lines other than bail bonds shall provide instruction by a qualified
11 instructor in a structured setting or by verifiable approved self-study with a minimum
12 of twenty hours of supervised instruction or self-study, including instruction in
13 applicable insurance principles, state laws and regulations, and ethical practices, for
14 each of the following lines of authority a license is sought: life, health and accident,
15 property, casualty, and personal lines.

Abstract: Exempts bail bond producer prelicensing programs from certain requirements.

Present law requires each registered insurance producer or bail bond producer prelicensing program to provide instruction by a qualified instructor in a structured setting or by verifiable approved self-study with a minimum of 20 hours of supervised instruction or self-study, including instruction in applicable insurance principles, state laws and regulations, and ethical practices, for each of the following lines of authority a license is sought: life, health and accident, property, casualty, and personal lines.

Proposed law exempts bail bond producer prelicensing programs.
