A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing to amend Article III, Section 4(A) and Article IV, Section 2 and to add Article III, Section 4(H) and Article IV, Section 3(E) of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative to the mandatory retirement age of certain elected officials; to require that certain elected officials retire at the age of seventy; to provide for related matters; and to specify an election for submission of the proposition to electors and provide a ballot proposition.

Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to amend Article III, Section 4(A) and Article IV, Section 2 and to add Article III Section 4(H) and Article IV Section 3(E) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:

ARTICLE III. LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

§4. Qualifications; Residence and Domicile Requirements; Term; Election Limitations; Vacancies; Temporary Successors; Salary

Section 4.(A) Age; Residence; Domicile. An elector who at the time of qualification as a candidate has attained the age of eighteen years **but has not**
