ENVIRONMENT/AIR: Requires vapor recovery systems at service stations

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 30:2054(B)(11), relative to air quality; to provide for the authority of the
3 secretary of the Department of Environmental Quality; to provide for rules and
4 regulations requiring vapor recovery systems on fuel dispensing equipment; and to
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 30:2054(B)(11) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §2054. Air quality control; secretary of environmental quality; powers and duties

9 * * *

10 B. The secretary shall have the following powers and duties:

11 * * *

12 (11) To adopt and promulgate rules and regulations requiring service stations
13 dispensing or selling motor vehicle fuel in this state to equip fuel dispensing devices
14 with a certified vapor recovery system, commonly known as a type II vapor recovery
15 system. Such rules and regulations shall provide for the classifications of service
16 stations, applications, training of personnel, testing, labeling, and recordkeeping.

Abstract: Requires vapor recovery systems on motor fuel dispensing equipment.

Present law requires the secretary of the Dept. of Environmental Quality to control the air resources of the state.

Proposed law requires the secretary to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations requiring service stations dispensing or selling motor vehicle fuel in this state to equip fuel pumps with a certified vapor recovery system, commonly known as a type II vapor recovery system.

Proposed law further requires such rules and regulations to provide for the classifications of service stations, applications, training of personnel, testing, labeling, and recordkeeping.
