Abstract: Increases the driver's license fee applicable to Class "D" and "E" driver's licenses and Class "A", "B", and "C" commercial driver's licenses by one dollar. Allows an applicant to donate one dollar to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

Present law establishes a class "D" driver's license fee of \$42.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the class "D" driver's license fee from \$42.75 to \$43.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

Present law establishes a class "D" driver's license fee of \$54.00 for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the class "D" driver's license fee from \$54.00 to \$55.00 for residents of the city of New Orleans.

Present law establishes a class "E" driver's license fee of \$20.25, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the class "E" driver's license fee from \$20.25 to \$21.25, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

Present law establishes a class "E" driver's license fee of \$20.25 for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the class "E" driver's license fee from \$20.25 to \$21.25 for residents of the city of New Orleans.

Present law establishes a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$61.50, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee from \$61.50 to \$62.50, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

Present law establishes a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$76.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee from \$76.50 to \$77.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans.

Present law establishes for applicants 70 years or older a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "E" driver's license from \$6.75 to \$7.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

Present law establishes for applicants 70 years or older a class "D" driver's license fee of \$22.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "D" driver's license from \$22.13 to \$23.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

Present law establishes for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

Proposed law increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, for a class "E" driver's license from \$6.75 to \$7.75.

Present law provides for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "D" driver's license fee of \$27.75. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

Proposed law increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, for a class "D" driver's license from \$27.75 to \$28.75.

Proposed law allows an applicant to donate one dollar of the license fees provided for in proposed law to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

Present law provides for funds received pursuant to present law to be deposited in the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

Proposed law adds the revenue derived from proposed law to the funds deposited in the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.
