MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Provides for a voluntary fee on driver's license applications to benefit the Military Family Assistance Fund

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 32:412(A)(8), relative to driver's license fees; to provide for a voluntary
3 donation to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund; and to provide for
4 related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 32:412(A)(8) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §412. Amount of fees; credit or refund; duration of license; veteran designation;
8 disabled veteran designation; university logo; "I'm a Cajun" designation;
9 disbursement of funds; renewal by mail or electronic commerce of Class "D"
10 or "E" drivers' licenses; disposition of certain fees; exception

13 (8) An applicant may choose to donate one dollar of the license fee required
14 by this Subsection to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.
