Amendments proposed by House Committee on Commerce to Original House Bill No. 502
by Representative ZeringueAMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 2, after "enact" and before "relative" delete "R.S. 4:65(A)(4) and 85(9)," and insert in lieu thereof "R.S. 4:61(G) and 65(A)(4),"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, at the end of line 7, delete "R.S. 4:65(A)(4) and" and insert in lieu thereof "R.S. 4:61(G) and 65(A)(4)"

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, at the beginning of line 8, delete "85(9)"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 1, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

"§61. State Boxing and Wrestling Commission; domicile; authority

* * *

G. The commission, the individual members of the commission, and the state of Louisiana shall not be liable for damages in any civil action for any event which is promoted pursuant to R.S. 4:83(B).

* * *"

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 1, line 13, after "wrestling" delete the remainder of the line, delete line 14 in its entirety, and insert in lieu thereof "promoter who, during the calendar year the promoter's license is granted, promotes exclusively events authorized by R.S. 4:83(B)."

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 1, delete lines 19 and 20 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"B. The provisions of R.S. 4:65(A)(2), 67(A) and (B), 68 through 70, 72, 73, and 79(C) shall not apply to any professional wrestling event provided all of the following conditions are met:"

AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 2, delete lines 1 through 16 in their entirety and insert the following:

"(1)The promoter and all the participants are licensed pursuant to R.S. 4:65(A)(1) and (B).

(2) The venue for the event is either a primary or secondary school gymnasium or has a capacity of four hundred persons or fewer as certified by the state fire marshal.

(3) There is present at each such event, from the start of the event until the finish of the event, an individual of the full age of majority, who is

1 not a participant in the event, who has documented current certification in
2 Infant/Child/Adult CPR.

3 (4) The promoter secures a commercial liability policy for a
4 minimum of onehundred thousand dollars or provides proof to the secretary
5 of the commission that the venue provides a liability policy in that amount,
6 which policy shall be in full force and effect at the time of the event.

7 (5) All applicable provisions of this Chapter and the rules and
8 regulations for the commission are observed and obeyed during the event.

9 (6) The promoter provides written notice to the secretary of the
10 commission no less than fifteen days prior to the event which certifies the
11 compliance with Paragraphs (1) through (5) of this Subsection and includes
12 verifying documents.

13 C. The following shall apply to any professional wrestling event
14 conducted pursuant to Subsection B of this Section:

15 (1) The promoter shall not be required by the commission to pay any
16 show date reservation fee nor shall any fee be charged for submission of the
17 written notice required by Paragraph (B)(6) of this Section.

18 (2) A promoter shall not be required by the commission to purchase
19 health insurance for the event.

20 (3) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the
21 commission shall not be required to have any representative present at the
22 event.

23 (4) The promoter shall at all times be responsible at the event for
24 compliance with the applicable provisions of this Chapter and the rules and
25 regulations of the commission.

26 (5) The promoter shall, within the fifteen days following the event,
27 report in writing the results of each event."
