SCHOOLS/BOARDS: Provides relative to the maximum and minimum size of school boards

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:71.2(A), relative to the size of school boards; to provide with
3 regard to the maximum and minimum size of school boards; and to provide for
4 related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 17:71.2(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §71.2. Maximum and minimum size of boards; four-year concurrent terms

8 A. In accomplishing the reapportionment authorized by this Subpart, each
9 ~~of said school boards~~ board may, by majority vote of ~~said~~ the board as presently
10 constituted, reestablish itself with not less than five nor more than fifteen members
11 or the number presently authorized for that school board, ~~whichever is the greater.~~

12 Whenever the size of a school board is to be changed by reapportionment, the school
13 board may submit the proposition of size to the people.

Abstract: Provides relative to maximum and minimum size of school boards.

Present law authorizes school boards (by majority vote) to reestablish their membership with not less than 5 nor more than 15 members or the number presently authorized for that school board, whichever is the greater.

Proposed law removes "whichever is the greater". Otherwise retains present law.
