



Allows a direct dental practice to discontinue care if a patient fails to pay the periodic fee, performs an act of fraud concerning the agreement, repeatedly fails to adhere to the recommended treatment plan, is abusive or presents a danger to the staff or other patients, or the direct dental practice discontinues operations.

Authorizes the board to promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate proposed law.

Provides that violations of proposed law constitute unprofessional conduct under R.S. 37:775 and result in sanctions as authorized in present law.

Effective August 1, 2019.
