



Proposed law permits each local review board to adopt rules pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act as necessary for its administration as long as those rules are not in conflict with the rules adopted by the State Board of Commerce and Industry. Any rule in conflict with the rules adopted by the State Board of Commerce and Industry shall be null, void and of no effect. The state board is authorized to act as a review board to determine if local review board rules are in conflict.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
