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Authorizes the establishment of arts-based programming at juvenile detention facilities

Proposed law provides for the OJJ to establish arts-based programming in specific juvenile institutions, facilities, and programs, which may include but is not limited to performing arts, visual arts, and other arts activities that enhance youth development. Proposed law authorizes the deputy secretary of OJJ for purposes of funding arts-based programming to receive, by appropriation, gift, grant, donation, or otherwise, any sum of money, aid, or assistance from any person, firm, or corporation or from the U.S., its agencies, the state of Louisiana, or any political subdivision of the state. Proposed law provides for specific juvenile detention licensed facilities owned or operated by any governmental, profit, nonprofit, private, or public agency may establish arts-based programming in the facility, which may include but is not to performing arts, visual arts, and other arts activities that enhance youth development. Proposed law authorizes a specific facility owner or operator to receive, by appropriation, gift, grant, donation, or otherwise, any sum of money, aid, or assistance from any person, firm or corporation or from the U.S., its agencies, the state of Louisiana, or any political subdivision of the state.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an increase in SGF expenditures for OJJ to establish arts-based programming in its juvenile institutions, facilities, and programs. OJJ reports the cost to establish this program annually is \$527,364 for 4 arts instructors, 4 JJS positions and supply expenses at each facility. Proposed law does not require the establishment of this program, it is permissive.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure. Proposed law authorizes the deputy secretary of OJJ for purposes of funding arts-based programming to receive, by appropriation, gift, grant, donation, or otherwise, any sum of money, aid, or assistance from any person, firm, or corporation or from the United States, its agencies, the state of Louisiana, or any political subdivision of the state.
