1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 56:116.1(D)(2), relative to hunting outlaw quadrupeds, nutria,
3 and beaver; to allow nighttime hunting of outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, and beaver on
4 private property at any time of the year; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 56:116.1(D)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §116.1. Wild birds and wild quadrupeds; times and methods of taking; penalties

11 (2) On private property, the landowner, or his lessee or agent with written
12 permission and the landowner's contact information in his possession, may take
13 outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver during nighttime hours ~~from one-half hour after~~
14 ~~official sunset on the last day of February to one-half hour after official sunset the~~
15 ~~last day of August of that same year.~~ However, no person shall be allowed to
16 participate or be present during nighttime hunting activities if convicted of a class
17 three or greater wildlife violation within the previous five years or if he has any other
